Hypothetical workflow

- 1. An Organisation Admin logs into Hub
- 2. If necessary they create a peer-review group
- 3. Using the group-id from a valid group, they compose the ORCID message
- 4. They upload a file containing the ORCID message(s) together with the email(s) of the individual(s) for whom the peer-review(s) is/are to be written.
- 5. They activate the file task:
 - I. If the Hub has a valid access token for this person, this information is written immediately
 - II. Otherwise, the Hub sends email requesting permission
- 6. Once all items acted on, the Hub sends the Organisation Admin notification of completion
- 7. The Organisation Admin can then export a file of ORCID iDs and putcodes for all items that were written.

Format your peer review data as either a json or yaml file. Multiple items can be specified but each **must** contain an invitees list together with the ORCID message schema compliant-data that is to be written to each invitee's ORCID record:

- Required for each invitee: "first-name"; "last-name"; and, "email"
- Required for each peer review message: "reviewer-role"; "review-identifiers"; "review-type"; "review-group-id", and "convening-organization"

A valid review-group-id must be specified. NB: Review Group IDs may be created in the Hub here.

On successful completion, the user's ORCID iD and item's put-code and visibility will be returned for each peer review item written. The Hub attempts to identify when information is an update rather than a new item; however, to explicitly update an item include a field with the item's put-code to specify which item is to be overwritten.
