Pattern name	Engaging first time users in online learning
Context	Exclusively online learning contexts
Problem	Students without experience of online learning may not be prepared to engage in online learning.
Solution	In Athena, set up an initial discussion with the students in smaller groups where they address a number of questions, such as:  How do we engage with each other in online settings?  How do we make the online environment one that is conducive to learning?  What makes the online environment different that the physical learning environment, what are the challenges and how do we address them?
Consequences and implications	By engaging the students in a discussion about how to engage in online learning the students may be better prepared for online course.
