Six months on - NHS England needs to focus on dissemination, implementation and audit of its Low Priority Initiative.

Here we describe the prescribing of 17 treatments considered by NHS England to be low-priority, for each month between January 2013 and June 2018. The NHS England low-priority consultation was started in July 2017, and the report resulting from the consultation was published in November 2017. We are therefore interested to see how prescribing changed following either of these dates.

The following figures (1-18) show prescribing for all treatments combined, then for each of the 17 treatments individually. The top graph shows the total number of items prescribed by GPs in England, for each treatment. The bottom graph shows deciles (10-90th) and extreme percentiles (1-9th and 91-99th) for the number of items prescribed by each CCG.


























