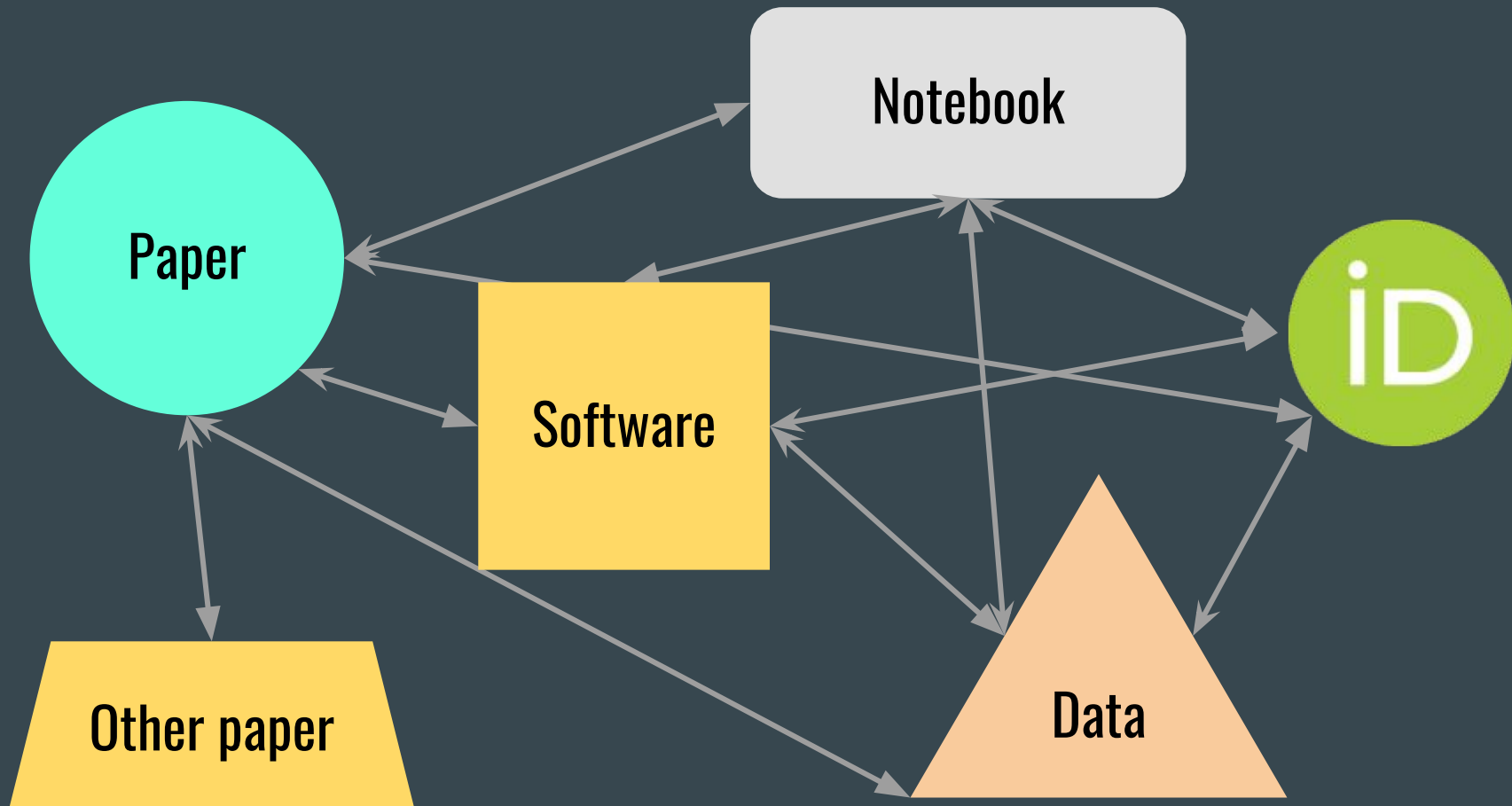

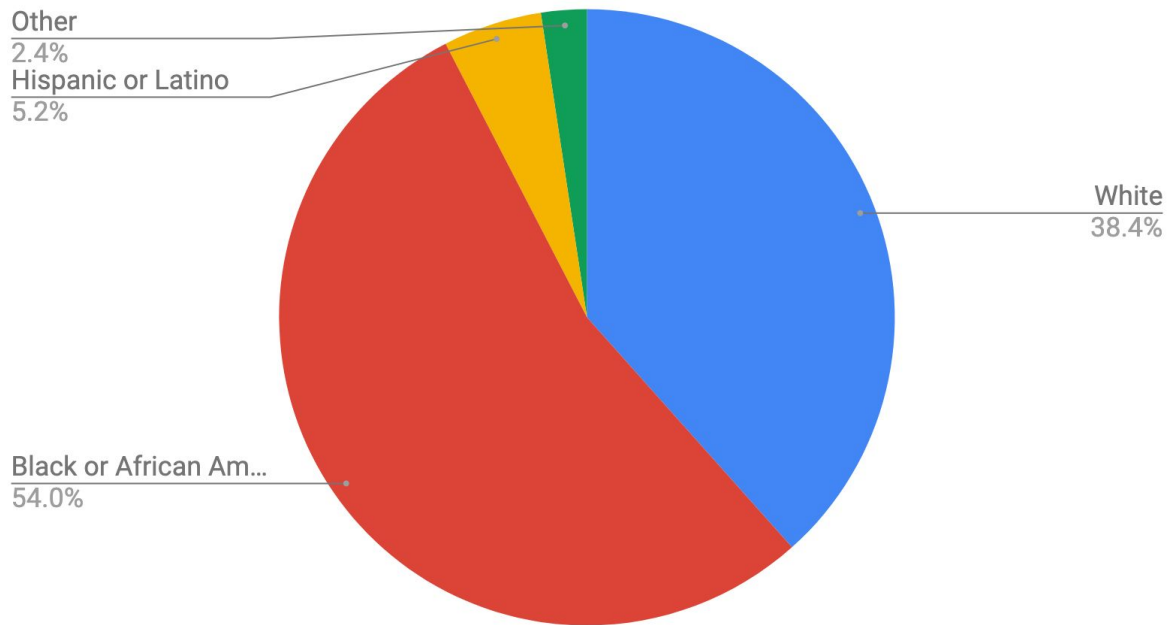

Use case

When researchers shifting home organizations they do not shift work tools and data

- We need to reconnect their tools and data to their new home organization federated login
- The ORCID identifier helps with reconnecting the researchers own resources in research infrastructures
- Home organizations vouch on who they are and give verified attributes based on their first hand knowledge of the researcher



A Diverse Community: ORCID

ORCID® id for Researchers 

ORCID is a registry of unique identifiers for researchers and scholars that is open, non-proprietary, transparent, mobile, and community-based. ORCID provides a persistent digital identifier that distinguishes you from every other contributor and supports automated linkages among all your professional activities.

ORCID is founded on interoperability with multiple systems and institutions. ORCID allows you to link with other identifier systems, including those maintained by funders and publishers, and exchange data freely with those research information systems.

Registration is free and fast for all researchers and scholars.

Why should I have an ORCID ID?

- Distinguishes you and enables your research outputs and activities to be correctly attributed to you
- Enables you to connect your work with your contributions and affiliations
- Reduces time spent on administrative tasks (e.g. journal submission, grant applications, research registration and dissemination, for example your research outputs)
- Enables you to connect your work with your contributions and affiliations

Your ORCID ID

Your ORCID ID is the hub in the globally interoperable environment, ensuring interoperability between you and your publisher(s), employer(s), and funder(s).

How do I make my ORCID ID more useful?

Visibility settings

Control your ORCID ID visibility settings for any information that you wish to share with others. You can choose to share your ORCID ID with the public, with specific groups of people, or to keep it private.

Linked addresses (aka ID)

Link your ORCID ID to other identifiers you have used in your career and any other identifiers or profiles that you wish to connect to your ORCID ID.

Other links (aka links to social media)

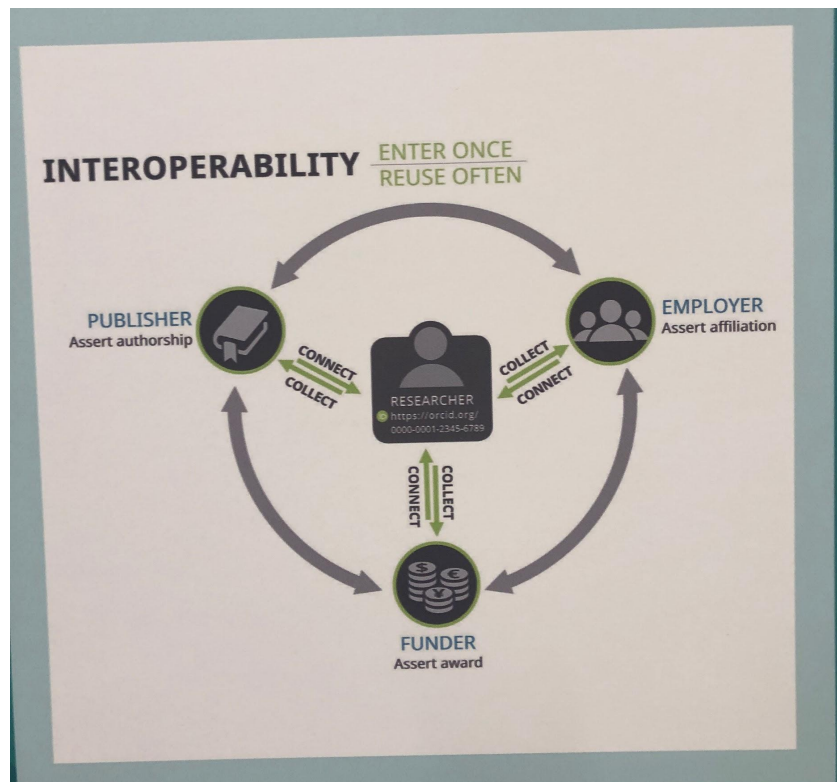


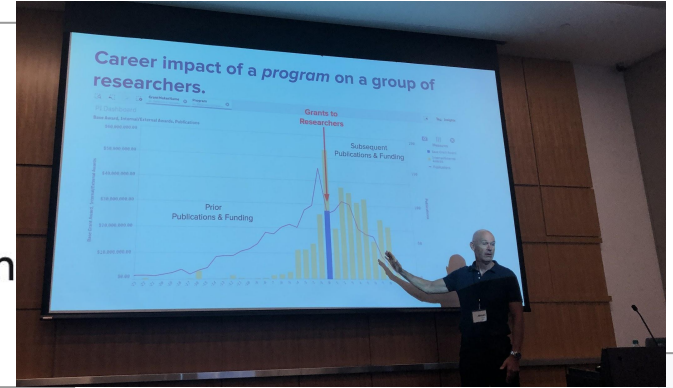
