

Problem we are trying to solve

People are often "required" (non-compliance rarely has consequences) to deposit research outputs (preprints, research data, more) in various places -- repositories, on-line profiles, publication offices, research sharing channels, CRIS systems.

Results:

- 1. Poor compliance
- 2. Unhappy people

Proposed Solution -- the Magic Place™

- Person drops their file(s) in the Magic Place™. One drop. Done.
- 1. The magic place magically appears wherever is best for the academic (authenticated web service)
- 2. Workflow is triggered as needed (Apache Camel)
- Content is formatted if needed (ImageMagick, Pandoc, ...)
 Metadata is automatically assembled -- from the identity of the person, and from the content (ORCID, inst. IDM system, grant system)
- Metadata magically appears on faculty profile, in the repository, in the CRIS system, through the publication office, research data channels, and wherever else it is needed -- consistently, magically, wonderfully.
 - 6. Person is congratulated as appropriate (Email, Tweet, ...)
 - 7. Person is happy. (Everyone is happy!)
